



Nana's Pantry located here at St. John's UMC is:

Without a doubt, this was a very tough week for our church and for me personally. One thing I've found to be very important is authenticity and vulnerability. So please be prepared for that this week. Let me start with Tuesday

Tuesday: For some reason I woke up way before I normally do on a day off. I jumped out of bed, showered and got dressed. I was just sitting down to start sipping coffee. My phone rings and I see its Heidi. Heidi doesn't call me on a weekend day unless...I answered to a hysterical Heidi who started trying to tell me something about Louis and his house and a neighbor and the sheriff. I immediately connected the dots, jumped into the car and flew over to the church. Through tears and a hug I headed over to the neighbor's house. They told me what they knew. Both Louis and his mom were found dead. One death seemed to be of natural causes the other self-inflicted. Shock, grief. and tears came flooding in. I went back to the church. Then I started making phone calls to key church leaders like Rex our SPRC chair, Terry our Lay Leader, and I left a text for Dave our church council chair. We made a short list of those who were very close and began making those calls. Each call guaranteed a reaction that was like a dagger. I finished up one thing I needed to do at home and then it was driving time. I made it home in time for our Trustees meeting that night. Yes, a sad, but also a productive meeting. It was so very exciting to see our new members, Glynn and Micheala jumping right in to take on tasks!

Wednesday: Today was going to be tough, but here goes! Checked in on the Men's Bible Study. Offered prayers and assurance. Weekly meeting with Heidi to go over what needed to get done this week. Went to see our preschool kiddos with my trusty, dusty lamp from our Sunday children's message. Christmas songs put away for the year. Thinking about what song I will do with them for their graduation in May. Got the last items needed for Beale Street Theater to use our space. Service planning for 01/19. Received a call from Albert and Deleen about transferring their membership to NE. Sniff, sniff, will do. Contacted all the funeral homes in Kingman to try to locate Louis and his mother only to realize they were taken to the coroner. Called the coroner to leave my phone number for Louis' sister to reach out to us. Made a call to someone who might be able to help with music for the traditional service while Lorena is recovering. Meeting on Friday! Set up a meeting with our Outreach committee chair. Noreen Frisch.

Thursday: Worked on service things for our Baptismal renewal. Will confess to feeling the weight of shock and grief still. Pastoral care session and Thursday night worship service. Mike Mixon's gift of music brought tears.

Friday: Greeted the food pantry people. Shared the news with those who didn't know. Started checking in on some of my seminary friends who were in the LA area. Wanted to be sure they were safe from the fires and they were. Had the pleasure of meeting Sandra Alward and Maria Lunawolf. The topic? Hoping that Sandra could help with music for the rest of January and the month of February. What a blessing this would be! We went through the specifics, addressed all questions. I had a list of things to find out and so did Sandra. We would regroup on Sunday. Touched base with Chris Commisso after the meeting, one of my tasks. Had a great quarterly meeting with the Missions team. We have some exciting plans to unveil very soon! So blessed to have people on this team jumping in to do things like reach out to local grocery stores with the possibility of receiving pantry goods from them.

Saturday: Woke up to a text from Linda Tucker that came in at 12:45 am. With her Parish Nurse newsletter article for February! You're going to love it! (No spoilers!) Worked on the sermon. Met with Ofa Savou Vaki. She is the appointed clergy at Advent UMC in Las Vegas. And she is my candidacy mentee. We needed to go over my evaluation for her. She's interviewing on the 21st! Keep her in prayer please. Met with my spiritual director for some processing of the events of the week. Had the pleasure of visiting with Barb and Dale McDaniel. Barb has been recovering from some health issues and hasn't been able to be at church. Back to finish all the parts of the service for Sunday. Home for pizza! Sunday: Arrived at church. Hard day. Had to make the announcement about Louis. Thank you to everyone for their loving concern! Organized a time to take down the greens on Friday the 17th at 3:00 pm. I so love the Baptismal Renewal service. Such a rich reminder of who we promise to be as followers of Christ. Thank you for everyone's participation. Finalized everything for Sandra to cover services for the rest of January and all of February. Finished my mentor report for Pastor Ofa. February newsletter, Weekly devotion, and Amy Odyssey. No Skippy and off to the Old Pueblo (Tucson).
